**ASSET MANAGEMENT:** In the November Communique, we focused on one or our Values – **sound stewardship**. One of the most important assets of Sumatanga is our land. On an ongoing basis, we are responsible for managing the property guided by Sumatanga's forest management plan which focuses on planting, culling and conserving the property. We have chosen a forestry professional to help us secure bids for selected tree harvesting, provide site management during the harvest and schedule the reforestation of those tracts. We are marking buffer-areas to ensure visual aesthetics and healthy topography are maintained. We anticipate payment when the contracts are signed allowing harvesting to begin in 2020 and continue through 2021. Proceeds from this asset management plan will be used first to create a reserve for reforestation and then used for general operations and capital improvements.

**HIRING FOOD SERVICE MANAGER:** We continue to look for an experienced Food Service Manager who is an important part of our Hospitality Team. This individual will be responsible for food quality, timely preparation of nourishing meals and detailed reporting to meet industry standards within a cost-effective kitchen operation. We anticipate his/her past experience will be from schools, hospitals and/or churches - camp kitchen familiarity is preferable. Details are posted on our website.
